BILLS SCORED

HOUSE BILL 5205

STATUS: STALLED IN THE SENATE

Redefines renewable energy to include the incineration of hazardous waste

SENATE BILL 78

STATUS: VETOED BY THE GOVERNOR

Prohibits the DNR from working to protect Michigan's biological diversity

HOUSE BILL 5806

STATUS: SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR

Opens the door for more energy efficiency upgrades at community colleges

SENATE BILL 891

STATUS: SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR

Significantly weakens Michigan's standards for contaminated site cleanup

SENATE BILL 910

STATUS: SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR

Prohibits the DEQ from drafting or enforcing new emissions standards for wood stoves

HOUSE BILL 5397

STATUS: SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR

Opens up on-bill financing programs for energy efficiency upgrades to customers of municipal utilities

HOUSE BILLS 5967, 5968, & 5969

STATUS: ALL ARE STALLED IN THE HOUSE

Expands and strengthens Michigan's commitments to renewable energy and energy efficiency
