Michigan LCV Launches Bill Tracker, Adds Tool to Accountability Suite

ANN ARBOR --- Michigan League of Conservation Voters (Michigan LCV) launched a new online bill tracking tool today, enhancing its set of accountability tools that track all three branches of Michigan's state government. The Michigan LCV Bill Tracker allows every citizen and elected official to track legislation that stands to impact Michigan's land, air, and water. Michigan LCV's Bill Tracker reports the status of legislation in play in Lansing, from the point of introduction to the Governor's sign off. The tool presents Michigan LCV's stance on top priority natural resources issues, and it holds legislators accountable by scoring their votes as positive or negative.

"Michigan LCV's Bill Tracker adds to our suite of online accountability tools, which make it easy for Michigan citizens to track their elected officials' job performance on environmental issues," said Lisa Wozniak, Executive Director for Michigan LCV. "We are pleased to debut one more resource that allows voters to keep a steady pulse on the critical decisions that are made every day in Lansing, and the impact those decisions have on our state's land, air, and water."

Michigan LCV's Bill Tracker connects current votes in the state legislature to Michigan LCV's *Environmental Scorecard*, which provides full context and details on a state legislator's record on conservation issues. On the Bill Tracker page, top priority bills are listed under "The Hot List" header, and users can search for bills by keyword, bill number or natural resource issue.
