Michigan LCV: Nofs energy plan would increase pollution and eliminate jobs in Michigan

LANSING – **Charlotte Jameson**, policy manager of **the Michigan League of Conservation Voters**, today testified before the Senate Energy and Technology Committee in opposition to Senate Bill 438.
